### Double White Lines at Wensley again....

We have seen an increase in calls again in relation to cars parked on the Solid White Line system through Wensley again.

Rule 240 of the highway code states you must NOT stop or park on a road marked with double white lines, even when a broken white line is on your side of the road, except to pick up or set down passengers, or to load or unload goods. Failing to comply will result in 3 penalty points and a fine.
