Please see below for crime prevention advice.

- · Fit good quality deadlocks to all exterior
- · Fit window locks, especially on ground floor windows
- Always lock doors and windows even when at home
- Consider a burglar alarm and set it when you go to bed
- · Take your house and car keys upstairs when you go to bed. Some crimes are committed by keys being

hooked through the letterbox.

• Make sure you know the identity of the person you are letting in to your home.
