This helps us to tackle the issues from a joint agency approach.

## **Positive results from your Safer Neighbourhood Team.**

We have seen a slight increase in the concerns around drug dealing within certain areas of our local community over the last few weeks. We have taken positive action in building and processing this information and with the support of our local Drone Unit, Dog Unit, Task Force Team and the assistance of our local Response Team, your Safer Neighbourhood Team conducted a Warrant at an address of concern.

One male detained, investigation on-going.

We would like to encourage you to continue reporting concerns of drug dealing/drug related activity/drug or drink driving to us via the correct channels to help us to keep our community and roads safe!

You can report this via:

- Phoning 999 if an emergency and it is happening there and then, this helps our officers to attend immediately and take positive enforcement action straight away!
